Rectory Farm: Relocation of Dutch Barn Agricultural Prior Notification

- The farm buildings at Rectory Farm are to be removed with a new housing development. These are the only agricultural buildings for Rectory Farm and the farmer wishes to relocate the existing Dutch Barn to provide a much need building for the farming operations on the remaining farm area.
- The Dutch Barn has a footprint of approximately 144m² (18.75m x 7.65m) and is 3.5m to eaves and 5.25m to ridge. The building is clad in corrugated steel sheeting which is unpainted, see photograph below.



- 3. An ecological report in December 2014 noted that the building was unsuitable for bats.
- 4. The site of the relocated Dutch Barn has been chosen so that it is in close proximity to the Farmhouse but located set back from the road for security reasons. A separate prior notification has been made for an associated road.
