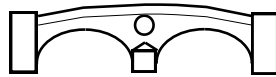


MAISEMORE PARISH COUNCIL



Minutes of Maisemore Parish Council meeting held on Monday 6th January 2020 at 7.30pm in the Committee Room of Maisemore Village Hall.

Items raised in the public session.

- Rectory Farm – Dog bins/Bat boxes and attenuation basin.

1. Apologies for Absence.

No apologies were received.

2. Declaration of Interests.

Councillors were reminded to send their register of interest forms to Tewkesbury Borough Council and to declare any personal or prejudicial interest in items on the agenda and their nature.
